Outing Info

Location

Lake Mead Marina 490 Horsepower Cove, Boulder City, NV 89005

Entrance fee is \$25. per vehicle, National Park passes are accepted.

Each driver will set departure time and location on Friday to arrive at the marina between 6pm and midnight. Scouts should expect to arrive back in Claremont at approximately 8pm, depending on traffic.
